- All submissions require a (VS 20) notarized sworn statement unless noted.
- If documents are not written in English, must include a certified English translation.
- Fees are dependent on when the request is submitted, please refer to <u>Vital Records Fees</u> to determine the fee amount.

Correct a <i>hospital or local</i> <i>registrar error</i> in the following fields: o child's sex o date, time, or place of birth		<ul> <li>Form must state "To correct hospital error" or "To correct local registrar error" in the reason for correction <i>AND</i> at least one signature must be from one of the following:         <ul> <li>Physician/Attendant at birth</li> <li>Hospital Administrator (if <i>the physician or attendant is unavailable</i>)</li> <li>Local Registrar representative</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Change sex field to reflect child's gender identity		<ul> <li>Without a court order, a child who is 12 years or older may self-attest to reflect their own gender identity:         <ul> <li>The reason field must state "To match the sex specified on my birth certificate to reflect my gender identity and not for any fraudulent purpose."</li> <li>The child must sign the application.                 <ul> <li>No additional signatures are required.</li> <li>If the registrant is under 12 years old, a court order is required.</li> <li>At least one parent or guardian is required to sign the application.</li> <li>Sign the application.</li> <li>The child number of guardian is required to sign the application.</li> <li>The child number of guardian is required to sign the application.</li> <li>The child number of guardian is required to sign the application.</li> <li>Sign the application.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Add parent's new name after a court ordered name change		<ul> <li>A certified copy of the parent's name change order is required.</li> <li>OR</li> <li>A photocopy of the parent's Naturalization Certificate for Name Change, from the Department of Homeland Security, is required.</li> </ul>
Change parent designation to reflect gender identity on their child's birth certificate	Form: <u>VS 24B – Application to Amend a</u> <u>Birth Record</u>	<ul> <li>At least one of the following:         <ul> <li>A certified copy of the court-ordered change of gender, including a certified English translation, if applicable.</li> <li>The parent's new birth certificate reflecting a change of gender and sex identifier.</li> <li>A government-issued identity document reflecting the parent's change of gender and sex identifier.</li> <li>An affidavit attesting under penalty of perjury that the request for a change of the designation of the petitioner as mother, father, or parent is to conform to the person's gender identity and is not made for a fraudulent purpose.</li> </ul> </li> <li>If child is over 18 years old, must include:</li> <li>A notarized letter from the adult child stipulating to the change to the adult child's birth certificate, "<i>I</i>, (adult child's full name), stipulate to an issuance of a new birth certificate for me that reflects my parent's legal gender and name."</li> </ul>
