Were you born in, traveled to, or have you lived in a country (for over a month) where TB is common?



Born or lived in a country where TB is common – anywhere, EXCEPT: United States, Canada, western or northern Europe, Australia, New Zealand






Have you lived with or spent time with someone who has had TB?
