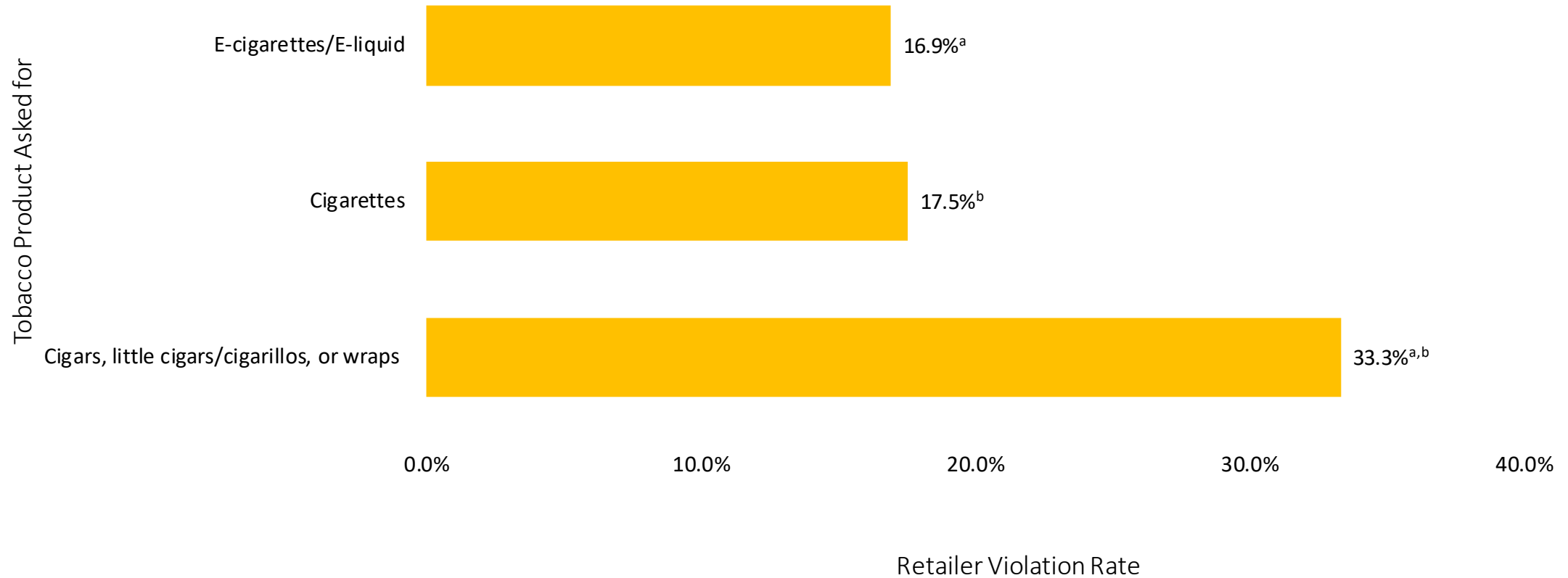
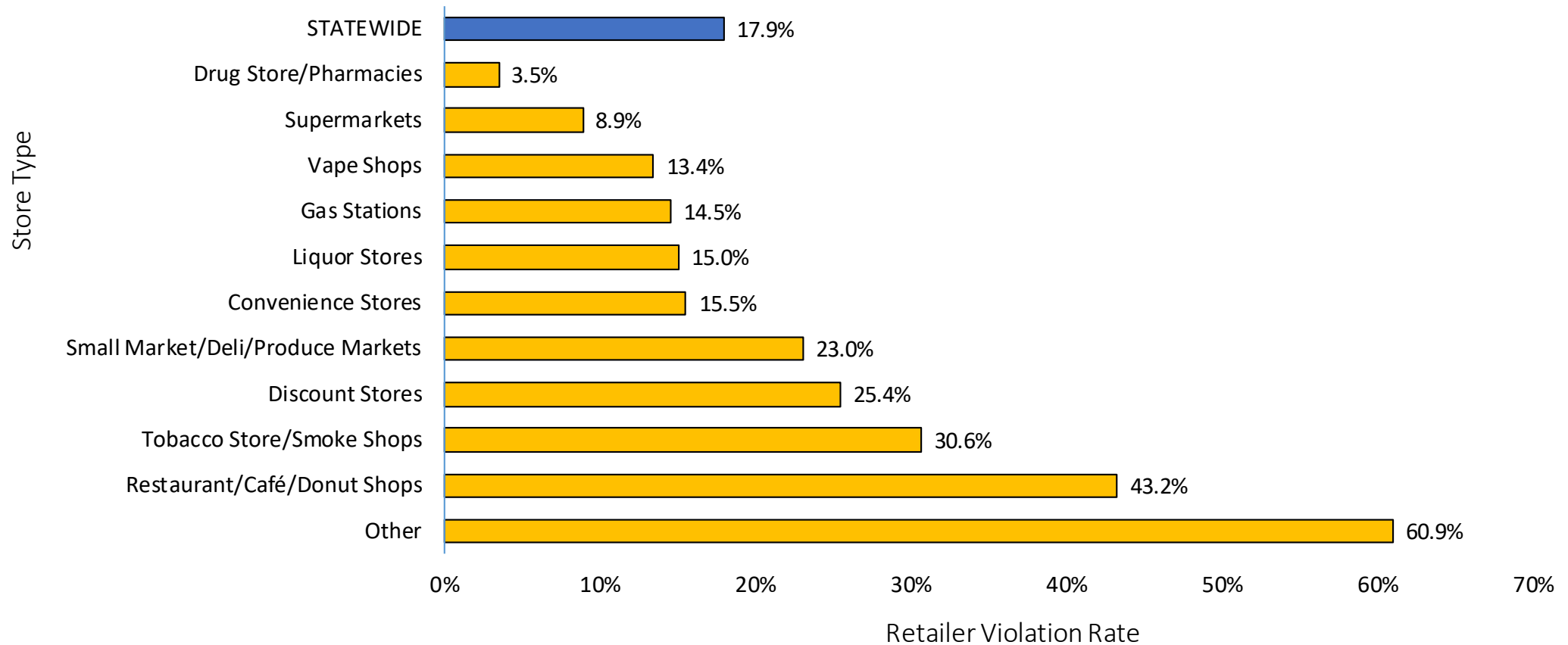

Notes: Protocols were randomly assigned for young adults to ask for cigarettes or e-cigarettes first. Young adult decoys were 18 - 19 years old. Only stores that are accessible to youth (e.g. stores that do not require membership, stores that do not enforce 21+ age restriction at the door) are inspected. TOBACCO SALES TO YOUNG ADULTS UNDER AGE 21 YEARS BY STORE TYPE, 2019

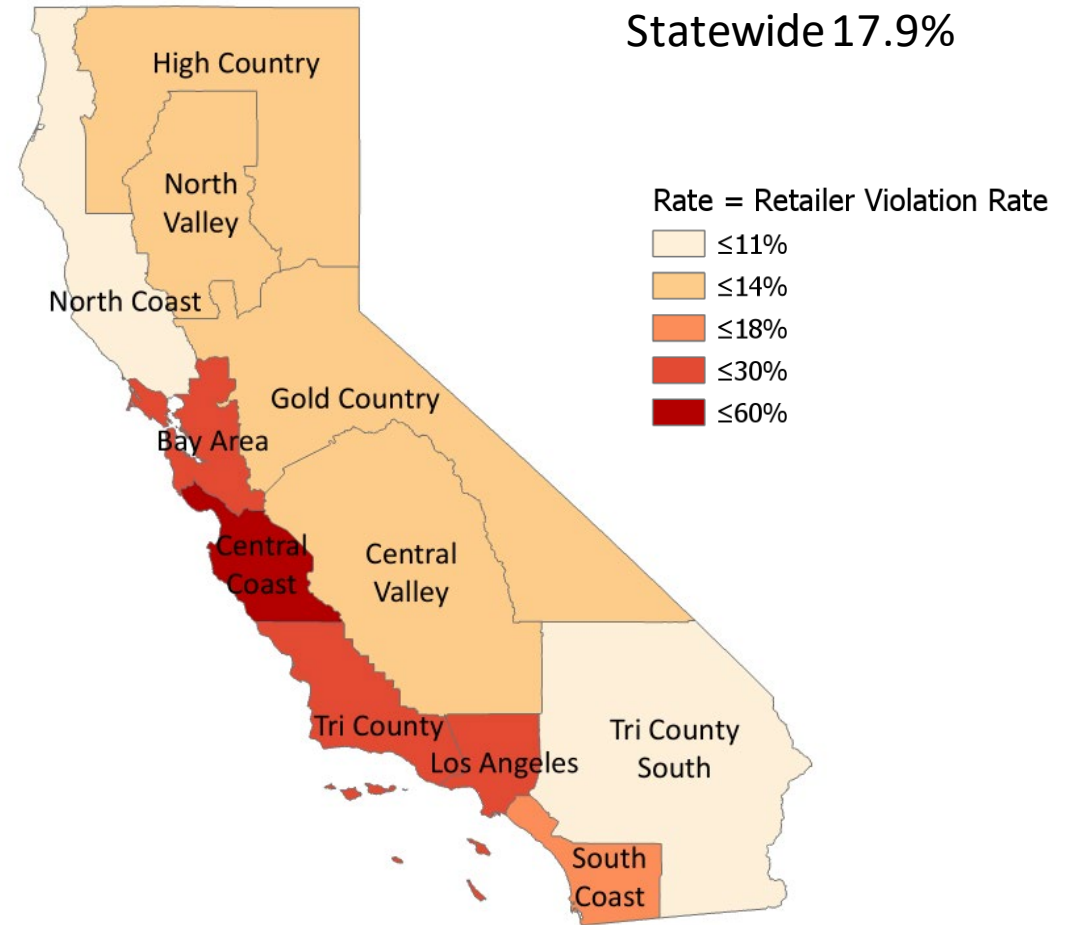
