GURU INC. Issues Voluntary Nationwide Recall of Infla-650 Herbal Dietary Supplement Capsules Due to Hidden Drug Ingredients

07/16/2024	<p>Infla-650 Herbal Dietary Supplement Capsules</p> <p>This is an unapproved new drug tainted with acetaminophen, diclofenac and phenylbutazone, which are not listed on the label.</p>	Guru Inc.	<p>Product is tainted with acetaminophen, diclofenac and phenylbutazone (not listed on the label). May cause accidental Acetaminophen overdose which may lead to liver damage like abnormalities in liver function to acute liver failure, and even death. Diclofenac may cause increased risk of cardiovascular events, such as heart attack and stroke, and serious gastrointestinal damage Phenylbutazone was discontinued for human use in the United States due to the risk of serious and life-threatening injuries like bone marrow toxicity. Patients with anemia, low white or red blood cell count, or decreased blood platelets may be at a</p>
