

About the Data – CHVP MIECHV By the Numbers

Data Source

California Department of Public Health, California Home Visiting Program (CHVP) Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program (MIECHV) Annual Performance Report. Compiled from data extracted from CHVP model-specific data systems in October of each reporting year.

Data Analysis

The CHVP MIECHV data shown in this dashboard are the numbers of families and children served, stratified by selected characteristics. For the purposes of this report, families are considered 'served' if they are enrolled for at least one day, and had at least one completed home visit, during the annual reporting period. The family record must also have 'MIECHV' chosen as the source of funding during the reporting period in the model-specific data system.

Reporting Period

The CHVP MIECHV data shown in this dashboard are summarized on a federal fiscal year (FFY) reporting period. Data are currently available for the following reporting periods:

- FFY 2021-22 (October 1, 2021-September 30, 2022)
- FFY 2022-23 (October 1, 2022-September 30, 2023)
- FFY 2023-24 (October 1, 2023-September 30, 2024)

Category and Subcategory Definitions

Age: Age of birthing parent or caregiver as reported at intake for newly enrolled participants and the most recent demographic response reported for continuing participants.

Race/Ethnicity: Hispanic includes all persons of Hispanic origin of any race, including Other and Unknown race. Multi-Race includes those of non-Hispanic origin who reported more than one race. The remaining groups are of non-Hispanic origin who reported a single race: American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, White, Multiracial, Other or Unknown.

Primary Language: Language spoken by participants at home most of the time reported as English, Spanish or Other. Other languages spoken by participant families include Arabic, Cantonese, Creole (Haitian), French, Hindi, Mandarin, Russian, Tagalog and Vietnamese.

Health Insurance: Medi-Cal health insurance coverage of participants. Other includes Private Insurance (paid for by participant or someone else, or by a job), Tri-Care, other types of insurance coverage, no insurance coverage, or unknown/did not report.
