**SUBJECT:** Notice to Public of Involuntary Termination of Chelsea Home Care

### Summary of Involuntary Termination

Chelsea Home Care is hereby involuntarily terminated from Medi-Cal participation, effective November 30, 2024 and this serves as notice to the public.

Notice is hereby given that on November 30, 2024, Chelsea Home Care, located at 6122 S Victoria Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90043-3945, as a Intermediate Care Facility for the Developmentally Disabled - Habilitative (ICF/DD-H) has been involuntarily terminated from Medi-Cal participation.

The California Department of Public Health has determined that Chelsea Home Care has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medi-Cal participation requirements.

The Medi-Cal program will not make payments for Intermediate Care Facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after **November 30, 2024**. For residents admitted prior to **November 30, 2024**, payments may continue for up to 30 days of services on or after **November 30, 2024**, the date of termination.

This action is mandated by Title 42, CFR, [§441.11](#), [§442.15\(b\)](#), and [§488.456](#).
