SUBJECT: DOXYCYCLINE POST-EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS (doxy-PEP) COVERAGE

In April 2023, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released <u>doxy-PEP</u> recommendations for the prevention of bacterial sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Doxycycline is an antibiotic that has activity against a wide range of bacterial infections. Emerging evidence from studies among men who have sex with men (MSM) and transgender women suggest that doxycycline, when taken as a 200mg oral dose within 72 hours of condomless oral, anal, or vaginal sex, significantly reduces the acquisition of chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis.

## ADAP and PrEP-AP Coverage:

Doxycycline is available on both the  $\underline{ADAP}$  and  $\underline{PrEP-AP}$  formularies. Clinicians may prescribe doxycycline for use as doxy-PEP without any additional authorizations or paperwork. As pharmacy benefits are structured to cover the cost of medications that are dispensed in one month or three-month intervals, it is recommended that clinicians prescribe an adequate amount of doxycycline to meet a patient's anticipated use for 1-3 months. Medications can be filled more than once per month in certain situations (e.g., if a patient has lost their medication) but these early refills may result in the need for additional approvals.
