Notice of Proposed Readopt of Emergency Regulations

Readopt of Emergency Regulations For Serving Size and Age for Industrial Hemp DPH-24-005E

Pursuant to Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) and California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 48, notice is hereby given that the California Department of Public Health (Department) proposes to readopt on an emergency basis sections 23000, 23005, 23015, and 23100 of Title 17, Division 1, Chapter 5, Subchapter 2.6 of the California Code of Regulations.

This notice is being provided at least five working days prior to the filing of the proposed readopt emergency regulatory action with the Office of Administrative Law (OAL). A copy of the text of the proposed emergency regulations and the finding of emergency are enclosed and available for review on the Department's website at: [Proposed Regulations \(ca.gov\)](https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/OPA/Pages/ProposedRegulations.aspx).

After submission of the proposed emergency to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6 to the OAL Reference Attorney by mail to 300 Capitol Mall, Suite 1250, Sacramento, California 95814, by fax to (916) 323-6826, or by e-mail to staff@oal.ca.gov.

This notice is solely a notice of intent to file a readopt of sections 23000, 23005, 23015, and 23100. Please note that section 23010 "List of Intoxicating Cannabinoids" does not require readoption and remains in effect for 18 months from September 23, 2024, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 111921.7(d).
